

Striped Throw

MEASUREMENTS

Length (approx - not including fringe)	cm	160
Width (approx)	cm	112

MATERIALS

CLECKHEATON FOLKLORE 50g balls

1st Colour (C1 – Colour 1)	3
2nd Colour (C2 – Colour 4)	7
3rd Colour (C3 – Colour 3)	5
4th Colour (C4 – Colour 2)	6
5th Colour (C5 – Colour 7)	6
6th Colour (C6 – Colour 6)	2
7th Colour (C7 – Colour 5)	2
8th Colour (C8 – Colour 8)	3

NOTE – This unique yarn knits to an individual tension. Substituting other yarns may change the measurements and result in an unsatisfactory item.

Quantities are approximate as they can vary between knitters. Check the ball bands to ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.

- 1 pair 7.50mm (UK 1) knitting needles or size needed to give correct tension.
- wool needle for sewing seams.

TENSION

This handknit has been designed at a tension of 13.5 sts and 19 rows to 10cm over stocking st, using 7.50mm needles.

To work a tension square, using 7.50mm needles, cast on 21 sts. Work 28 rows stocking st. Cast off loosely.

Check your tension carefully.

If less sts to 10cm use smaller needles, if more sts use bigger needles.

NOTE – This rug has been knitted on bigger needles and at a looser tension than normally recommended.

STRIP 1

Work cast on row and twisted tails together –

** Using 7.50mm needles and **C1**, cast on 28 sts, * cast off 24 sts firmly, slip stitch on right-hand needle onto left-hand needle, cast on 28 sts, rep from * 3 times, cast off 24 sts firmly, slip stitch on right-hand needle onto left-hand needle, cast on 3 sts ... 23 sts and 5 twisted tails. **

Working in stocking st, work 16 rows, beg with a knit row.

Using **C2**, work 16 rows.

Using **C1**, work 16 rows.

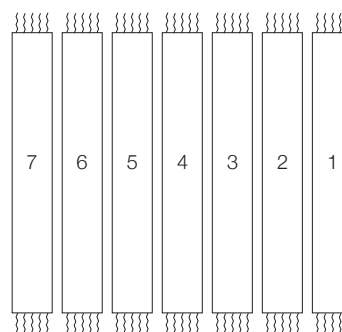
Rep last 32 rows 8 times.

Work cast off row and twisted tails together –

Using **C1**, **Next row** – Cast off 3 sts, * slip stitch on right-hand needle onto left-hand needle, cast on 24 sts, cast off 28 sts firmly, rep from * to end ... 5 twisted tails.

STRIP 2

Using **C3** in place of **C1**, work cast on row as given for strip 1 from ** to **.

Working in stocking st, work 4 rows, beg with a knit row.

Using **C4**, work 8 rows.

Using **C3**, work 8 rows.

Rep last 16 rows 17 times.

Using **C4**, work 8 rows.

Using **C3** for rem, work 4 rows.

Work cast off row and twisted tails together –

Next row – Cast off 3 sts, * slip stitch on right-hand needle onto left-hand needle, cast on 24 sts, cast off 28 sts firmly, rep from * to end ... 5 twisted tails.

STRIP 3

Work as given for strip 1 using **C5** in place of **C1**, and **C6** in place of **C2**.

STRIP 4

Work as given for strip 2 using **C3** as given and **C7** in place of **C4**.

STRIP 5

Work as given for strip 1 using **C8** in place of **C1**, and **C4** in place of **C2**.

STRIP 6

Work as given for strip 2 using **C2** in place of **C3**, and **C4** as given.

STRIP 7

Work as given for strip 1 using **C5** in place of **C1**, and **C2** as given.

TO MAKE UP

NOTE – We recommend using mattress st to sew up your throw.

DO NOT PRESS. Sew all strips together in number order from 1 to 7 working from right to left as illustrated. Sew in ends.
