

Frilly Scarf



Measurements

		Long	Short
Width (approx)	cm	10	13
Length (approx)	cm	145	90

Materials

Panda Sashay 100g balls

Quantity 1 1

- 1 pair 5.50mm (UK 5) knitting needles.

Tension

Tension is not important for this project.

Scarf

Note – You will need to start with 6 sts for a longer scarf or 10 sts for a shorter scarf.

To cast on these sts, first stretch the end of the Sashay yarn open for approximately 15cm and lay it flat, placing the edge with the metallic thread along the bottom. Notice that the Sashay yarn is a mesh of holes. You will be working along the top holes of the mesh and leaving the metallic edge loose to form a fringe. You are using the top section of large mesh holes as if it is a length of yarn.

Step 1 – cast-on

Beginning at the top right edge (approx 5cm from end), insert the tip of one 5.50mm knitting needle from front to back into the first large mesh hole. The loop now on your needle will be your first st. Continue inserting your knitting needle into the next large hole along in the mesh to make 6 (10) loops in all on your needle (see diagram 1).



Step 2 – first knit row

Holding the needle with the sts in your left hand, insert the other 5.50mm needle as though to knit, through the first loop on your left-hand needle. With the length of Sashay in your right hand, wind the yarn up towards the point of your right-hand needle (as if to knit), slipping the 2nd mesh hole onto the right-hand needle, then complete the stitch in the usual way (see diagram 2). Continue to knit the remaining sts, winding the yarn at every alternate mesh hole.



Continue knitting each row in the same manner, carefully stretching the yarn open as you work and working along the top edge of the mesh as before, until 15cm of yarn is left. This will create the frills of your scarf (see diagram 3).



Step 3 – cast-off

Cast off loosely in the usual manner using the top mesh holes in the yarn as before. Draw the end of the yarn through the last st and tighten securely. Trim each end so that the ends of the yarn are concealed in the frills.
