

# HOODIE



Intermediate

Months		3	6	9	12	18
To Fit Chest	cm	40	45	50	53	55
Actual Size	cm	45	50	55	58	60
Length (approx)	cm	26	29	33	34	35
Sleeve Length (approx)	cm	13	16	19	21	23

## Materials

### Baby Cloud Soft 100g balls

Quantity		2	2	3	3	4
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Use only the yarn specified. Other yarns are likely to produce different results. Quantities are approximate as they can vary between knitters.

Check the ball bands to ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.

- 1 pair each 6.50mm (UK 3) and 7.00mm (UK 2) knitting needles.
- wool needle and plain yarn for sewing seams.
- 3 buttons.

## TENSION

10 sts and 17 rows to 10cm over stocking st, using 6.50mm needles.

To work a tension square, using 6.50mm needles, cast on 15 sts.

Work 26 rows stocking st. Cast off loosely.

Check your tension carefully.

If less sts to 10cm use smaller needles, if more sts use bigger needles.

## Back

Using 7.00mm needles, cast on **28** (30-32-34-38) sts **loosely**.

Change to 6.50mm needles and work **4** (4-8-6-8) rows stocking st.

### Shape Sides –

Dec one st at each end of next row, then in foll 14th row once ...

**24** (26-28-30-34) sts.

Work **7** (9-11-13-11) rows.

### Shape Armholes –

Cast off 2 sts loosely at beg of next 2 rows ... **20** (22-24-26-30) sts.

Work **16** (18-20-22-24) rows.

### Shape Shoulder –

Cast off **3** (4-4-5-7) sts **loosely** at beg of next 2 rows.

Using 7.00mm needles, cast off rem **14** (14-16-16-16) sts **loosely**.

## Left Front

Using 7.00mm needles, cast on **17** (18-19-20-22) sts **loosely**.

Change to 6.50mm needles and work **4** (4-8-6-8) rows stocking st.

### Shape Side –

**Next row** – K2tog, knit to end ... **16** (17-18-19-21) sts.

Work **21** (23-25-27-25) rows, AT SAME TIME dec one st at side

edge in 14th row ... **15** (16-17-18-20) sts.

### Shape Armhole –

**Next row** – Cast off 2 sts **loosely**, knit to end ... **13** (14-15-16-18) sts.

Work **12** (14-16-18-20) rows.

### Shape Neck –

**Next row** – Cast off 7 sts **loosely**, purl to end ... **6** (7-8-9-11) sts.

Dec one st at neck edge in every row until **3** (4-4-5-7) sts rem.

Work **1** (1-0-0-0) rows.



### Shape Shoulder –

Using 7.00mm needles, cast off rem **3** (4-4-5-7) sts **loosely**.

## Right Front

Using 7.00mm needles, cast on **17** (18-19-20-22) sts **loosely**.

Change to 6.50mm needles and work **4** (4-8-6-8) rows stocking st.

### Shape Side –

**Next row** – Knit to last 2 sts, K2tog ... **16** (17-18-19-21) sts.

Work 5 rows.

**Next row** – K1, K2tog, yfwd, knit to end (buttonhole).

Work 8 rows, dec one st at side edge in last row ... **15** (16-17-18-20) sts.

Work **3** (5-7-9-9) rows.

**Next row** – K1, K2tog, yfwd, knit to end (buttonhole).

Work **4** (4-4-4-2) rows.

### Shape Armhole –

**Next row** – Cast off 2 sts **loosely**, purl to end ... **13** (14-15-16-18) sts.

Work **6** (8-10-12-14) rows.

**Next row** – K1, K2tog, yfwd, knit to end ... 3 buttonholes.

Work 3 rows.

### Shape Neck –

**Next row** – Cast off 7 sts **loosely**, knit to end ... **6** (7-8-9-11) sts.

Work 1 row.

Dec one st at neck edge in every row until **3** (4-4-5-7) sts rem.

Work **2** (2-1-1-1) rows.

### Shape Shoulder –

Using 7.00mm needles, cast off rem **3** (4-4-5-7) sts **loosely**.

## Sleeves

Using 7.00mm needles, cast on **18** (18-**20**-20-**20**) sts **loosely**.  
Change to 6.50mm needles and work 4 rows stocking st.  
Cont in stocking st, inc one st at each end of next row, then in every foll **10th** (8th-**16th**-12th-**12th**) row until there are **22** (24-**24**-26-**26**) sts.  
Cont without further shaping until Sleeve measures **13** (16-**19**-21-**23**) cm from beg, ending with a purl row.

### Shape Top –

Cast off 2 sts **loosely** at beg of next 2 rows ... **18** (20-**20**-22-**22**) sts.  
Dec one st at each end of next row, then in every foll alt row until **14** (14-**10**-14-**10**) sts rem, then in every row until 4 sts rem.  
Cast off rem 4 sts **loosely**.

## Hood (worked in two pieces)

### Left Piece –

Using 7.00mm needles, cast on **16** (16-**17**-18-**18**) sts **loosely**.  
Change to 6.50mm needles and work **32** (32-**36**-40-**40**) rows stocking st. \*\*  
Dec one st at beg of next row, then at same edge in every row until **8** (8-**9**-10-**10**) sts rem.  
Using 7.00mm needles, cast off **loosely**.

### Right Piece –

Work as for Left Piece to \*\*.  
Dec one st at end of next row, then at same edge in every row until **8** (8-**9**-10-**10**) sts rem.  
Using 7.00mm needles, cast off **loosely**.

### Ears (make 2)

Using 6.50mm needles, cast on 4 sts.  
Work 6 rows stocking st.  
Cast off **loosely**.

### To Make Up

DO NOT PRESS. Join shoulder seams. Join side and sleeve seams. Sew in sleeves. Join back and top seam (shaped edges) of hood together. Sew cast-on edge of hood to neck edge, **noting** to place seam at centre back neck and beginning and ending at edges of fronts, easing any extra fullness to backneck. Sew on buttons. Attach ears to hood as pictured.
