

# MAGNUM THROW

## Measurements

Measures (approx) cm 100 x 130

## Panda Magnum 8 ply 100g balls

**2 balls** of Geranium (307)

**1 ball** each of Aqua (1007), Mint (315), Emerald (394), Lime Sorbet (1004), Fuchsia (381), Rose Sorbet (1002), Musk Pink (1069), Lemon Sorbet (1003), Inca Gold (336), Aran (309) and Orange (378)

Use only the yarn specified. Other yarns are likely to produce different results.

## Needles and Extras

- 1 pair 4.5mm (UK 7) knitting needles or size needed to give correct tension.
- wool needle for sewing seams.

## Tension

19.5 sts and 36 rows to 10cm over garter st, using 4.5mm needles.

To work a tension square, using 4.5mm needles, cast on 29 sts. Work 54 rows garter st (every row knit).

Cast off loosely.

Check your tension carefully.

If less sts to 10cm use smaller needles, if more sts use larger needles.

**NOTE** – This Throw is worked on larger needles and at a looser tension than usually recommended for this yarn.

## Abbreviations

**garter st** = every row knit; **st, sts** = stitch, stitches

## SQUARE (Make 12)

Working from diagrams for colour order and following instructions, make 4 Squares in each of Golds, Pinks and Greens ... 12 Squares in total.

Using 4.5mm needles and 1st Block colour, cast on 12 sts.

### 1st Block –

Work 23 rows garter st (knit every row – first row is wrong side). Cast off loosely.

### 2nd Block –

With right side of 1st Block facing and using 2nd Block colour, knit up 12 sts along left side edge (one st in each garter st ridge). Work 23 rows garter st.

Cast off loosely.

### 3rd Block –

With right side of Blocks facing, beginning at top of 2nd Block (cast-off edge) and using 3rd Block colour, knit up 12 sts along left side edge of 2nd Block, then knit up 12 sts across cast-on sts of 1st Block ... 24 sts.

Work 23 rows garter st.

Cast off loosely.

### 4th Block –

With right side of Blocks facing, beginning at top of 3rd Block and using 4th Block colour, knit up 12 sts along left side edge of 3rd Block, then knit up 12 sts along side edge of 1st Block ... 24 sts.

Work 23 rows garter st.

Cast off loosely.



### 5th Block –

With right side of Blocks facing, beginning at top of 4th Block and using 5th Block colour, knit up 12 sts along left side edge of 4th Block, then knit up 12 sts across cast-off sts of 1st Block, then knit up 12 sts along side edge of 2nd Block ... 36 sts.

Work 23 rows garter st.

Cast off loosely.

### 6th Block –

With right side of Blocks facing, beginning at top of 5th Block and using 6th Block colour, knit up 12 sts along left side edge of 5th Block, then knit up 12 sts across cast-off sts of 2nd Block, then knit up 12 sts along side edge of 3rd Block ... 36 sts.

Work 23 rows garter st.

Cast off loosely.

### 7th Block –

With right side of Blocks facing, beginning at top of 6th Block and using 7th Block colour, knit up 12 sts along left side edge of 6th Block, then knit up 24 sts across cast-off sts of 3rd Block, then knit up 12 sts along side edge of 4th Block ... 48 sts.

Work 23 rows garter st.

Cast off loosely.

### 8th Block –

With right side of Blocks facing, beginning at top of 7th Block and using 8th Block colour, knit up 12 sts along left side edge of 7th Block, then knit up 24 sts across cast-off sts of 4th Block, then knit up 12 sts along side edge of 5th Block ... 48 sts.

Work 23 rows garter st.

Cast off loosely.

### 9th Block –

With right side of Blocks facing, beginning at top of 8th Block and using 9th Block colour, knit up 12 sts along left side edge of 8th Block, then knit up 36 sts across cast-off sts of 5th Block, then knit up 12 sts along side edge of 6th Block ... 60 sts.

Work 23 rows garter st.

Cast off loosely, completing square.

## Join Squares –

NOTE – We recommend using mattress stitch to sew up your squares.

Join squares together following Assembly Diagram.

## SIDE BORDERS (Make 2)

Using 4.5mm needles and Geranium, cast on 10 sts.

Work in garter st until border is long enough to fit (slightly stretched) along side edges.

Cast off.

Sew Side Borders in position.

## UPPER AND LOWER BORDERS (Make 2)

Using 4.5mm needles and Geranium, cast on 10 sts.

Work in garter st until border is long enough to fit (slightly stretched) along short ends, including Borders.

Cast off.

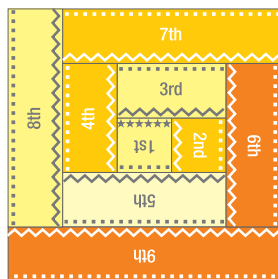
Sew Upper and Lower Borders in position.

## TO MAKE UP

DO NOT PRESS. Sew in ends.

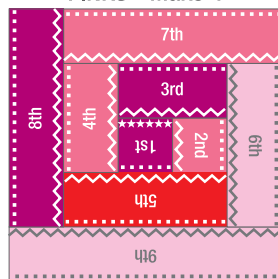

### GOLDS - Make 4



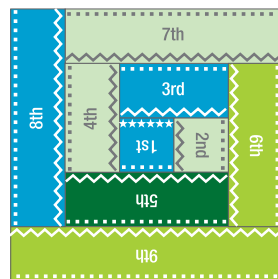
Lemon Sorbet Aran

### GREENS - Make 4



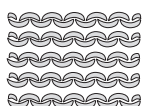
Aqua Emerald

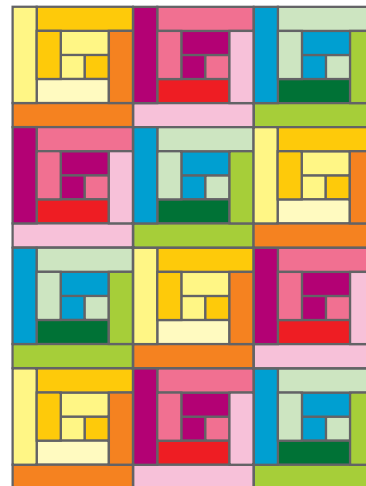
~ Knit-up edge
