# Hoodie Jumper



## Hoodie Jumper (intermediate)

#### **MEASUREMENTS**

Months 6 (9-12-18-24)

To fit underarm

45 (47-50-53-55) cms/18 (19-20-21-22) ins

To measure

52 (**55**-58-**61**-63) cms/21 (**22**-23-**24**-25) ins **Length** (approx)

29 (31-33-35-40) cms/11½ (12-13-14-16) ins Sleeve length

16 (18-19-21-23) cms/6 (7-7½-8-9) ins

#### PANDA CHENILLE YARN

2 (3-3-4-5) x 50g balls

#### **NEEDLES**

A pair each 5.00mm (US 8), (UK 6) and 4.00mm (US 6), (UK 8) Knitting Needles **or size that gives correct tension/gauge.** 

#### **MATERIALS**

A Yarn Needle; 2 Buttons.

#### TENSION/GAUGE

13 sts and 26 rows to 10 cms/4 ins over stocking st, using 5.00mm (US 8), (UK 6) Knitting Needles.

Note - Correct tension/gauge is essential for a successful handknit.

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

**St/s** - stitch/es, **K** - Knit, **P** - Purl, **RS** - right side, **WS** - wrong side, **stocking st** - 1 row K, 1 row P, **rep** - repeat, **beg** - begin/ning, **dec** - decrease, **foll** - follow/ing, **alt** - alternate, **rem** - remain/ing, **cont** - continue, **K2tog** - knit 2 sts together, **inc** - increase, **yfwd** - yarn forward to make a stitch, **tog** - together.

#### **CREATE - Back**

Using 4.00mm (US 6), (UK 8) Needles, cast on 35 (**37**-39-**41**-43) sts.

**1st row** (RS) - K2, \* P1, K1, rep from \* to last st. K1.

**2nd row** - K1, \* P1, K1, rep from \* to end. Rep 1st and 2nd rows 3 (**3**-4-**4**-4) times = 8 (**8**-10-**10**-10) rows rib in total. Change to 5.00mm (US 8), (UK 6) Needles. Work in stocking st until work measures 16 (17-18-19-24) cms/6 (61/2-7-71/2-91/2) ins from beg, ending with a purl row.

**Shape raglan armholes** - Cast/bind off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows = 31 (33-35-37-39) sts. \*\* Dec one st at each end of next row, then in every foll 4th row until 15 (17-17-17-21) sts rem, then in every foll alt row until 13 (13-13-15-15) sts rem.

Work 1 row. Cast/bind off rem sts loosely.

#### **Front**

Work as for Back to \*\*.

Dec one st at each end of next row, then in 4th row = 27 (29-31-33-35) sts.

Work 1 row.

**Divide for front opening - Next row** (RS) - K11 (**12**-13-**14**-15), cast/bind off next 5 sts loosely, knit to end.

\*\*\* Cont on these 11 (12-13-14-15) sts and dec one st at ragian edge in 2nd row, then in every foll 4th row 2 (2-3-3-3) times = 8 (9-9-10-11) sts. Work 3 rows.

**Shape neck - Next row** (RS) - K2tog, knit to last 2 sts, K2tog = 6 (7-7-8-9) sts.

Dec one st at raglan edge in every foll 4th row 2 (2-2-3-2) times, then in every foll alt row 1 (2-2-1-3) time/s, at the same time dec one st at neck edge in every foll 4th row 1 (1-1-2-2) time/s = 2 sts.

**Next row** - P2, **turn**, K2tog. Fasten off. \*\*\*
With WS facing, join yarn to rem sts and rep from \*\*\* to \*\*\*.

#### Sleeve (make 2)

Using 4.00mm (US 6), (UK 8) Needles, cast on 19 (21-21-23) sts.

Work 8 (8-10-10-10) rows rib as for lower band of Back.

Change to 5.00mm (US 8), (UK 6) Needles. Work in stocking st, inc one st at each end of 3rd row, then in every foll 8th (10th-10th-8th-10th) row until there are 27 (29-29-31-33) sts. Cont without shaping until work measures 16 (18-19-21-23) cms/6 (7-7½-8-9) ins from beg, ending with a purl row.

**Shape ragian** - Cast/bind off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows = 23 (25-25-27-29) sts.

Dec one st at each end of next row, then in every foll 4th row until 7 (9-5-7-11) sts rem, sizes 6, 9, 18 and 24 months only - then in every foll alt row until 5 sts rem.

All Sizes - Work 1 row.

Cast/bind off rem sts loosely.

#### Hood

Using 4.00mm (US 6), (UK 8) Needles, cast on 63 (**65**-67-**69**-71) sts.

Work 8 rows rib as for lower band of Back. Change to 5.00mm (US 8), (UK 6) Needles. Work in stocking st until hood measures 12 (13-13-14-16) cms/5 (5-5-51/2-6) ins from beg, ending with a purl row.

Shape back of hood - Next row - K31 (32-33-34-35), turn.

Cont on these 31 (**32**-33-**34**-35) sts and decone st at inside edge in every row until 24 (**25**-26-**27**-28) sts rem.

Cast/bind off loosely.

With RS facing, join yarn to rem sts at inside edge, K2tog, knit to end.

Complete as for other side.

#### **Right Front Band**

With RS facing and using 4.00mm (US 6), (UK 8) Needles, knit up 13 (**15**-15-**19**-19) sts evenly along right front opening.

Work 2 rows rib as for lower band of Back, beg with a 2nd row.

**3rd row** - Rib 2, yfwd to make a stitch, rib 2tog, rib 3 (**4**-4-**6**-6), yfwd to make a stitch, rib 2tog, rib 4 (**5**-5-**7**-7) = 2 buttonholes in total.

Work 4 rows rib.

Cast/bind off loosely in rib.

#### **Left Front Band**

With RS facing and using 4.00mm (US 6), (UK 8) Needles, knit up 13 (**15**-15-**19**-19) sts evenly along left front opening.

Work 7 rows rib as for lower band of Back, beg with a 2nd row.

Cast/bind off loosely in rib.

#### **FINISHING**

DO NOT PRESS. Using yarn needle, darn in all ends.

Using yarn needle and mattress st seam, join raglan seams, noting that tops of sleeves form part of neckline. Join side and sleeve seams. Place right front band over left front band and stitch side edge of front bands to sts cast/bound off at centre front, sewing through all thicknesses. Join centre back seam of hood, then using a flat seam sew hood in position, beg and ending in centre of front bands and easing any extra fullness to back neck. Sew on buttons.
