Use only the yarn specified for this garment. Other yarns may give unsatisfactory results. Quantities are approximate as they can vary between knitters.

NEEDLES AND EXTRAS

- 1 pair 4.00mm (UK 8) knitting needles, or size needed to give correct tension.
- wool needle for sewing seams.
- length of satin ribbon for Jacket.

TENSION

20 sts and 28 rows to 10cm over stocking st, using 4.00mm needles.

To work a tension square, use 4.00mm needles, cast on 30 sts. Work 42 rows stocking st. Cast off loosely.

Check your tension carefully.

If less sts to 10cm use smaller needles, if more sts use bigger needles.

JACKET

BACK

NOTE - With correct tension, your garment will look like our photograph.

Using 4.00mm needles, cast on 44 (**48-54-58-60-64**) sts. Work 12 (**18-20-22-26-28**) rows stocking st.

Shape Armholes -

Cast off 2 (**2-3-3-3-4**) sts at beg of next 2 rows ... 40 (**44-48-52-54-56**) sts.



Dec one st at each end of next row, then in every foll alt row until 36 (**40-44-46-48-50**) sts rem.

Cont without shaping until **armhole** measures 10 (**11-12-13-13-14**) cm from beg, ending with a purl row.

Shape Shoulders -

Cast off 5 (**6-8-8-9-10**) sts at beg of next 2 rows.

Cast off rem 26 (**28-28-30-30-30**) sts loosely.

LEFT FRONT

Using 4.00mm needles, cast on 4 (**3-3-5-3-5**) sts.

Working in stocking st, cast on 3 sts at **beg** (front edge) of every foll alt row until there are 16 (**18-21-23-24-26**) sts.

Work 4 (**8-8-10-12-14**) rows stocking st ... 12 (**18-20-22-26-28**) rows in all.

Shape Armhole & Front Slope -

Cast off 2 (**2-3-3-3-4**) sts at beg of next row ... 14 (**16-18-20-21-22**) sts.

Dec one st at armhole edge in every foll alt row 2 (**2-2-3-3-3**) times, AT SAME TIME dec one st at front edge in every foll alt row 4 (**4-3-4-4-2**) times, then in every foll 4th row until 5 (**6-8-8-9-10**) sts rem.

Cont without shaping until **armhole** measures same as Back to beg of shoulder shaping, ending with a purl row.

Shape Shoulder -

Cast off rem 5 (**6-8-8-9-10**) sts.

RIGHT FRONT

Using 4.00mm needles, cast on 4 (**3-3-5-3-5**) sts.

Work 2 rows stocking st.

Cont in stocking st, casting on 3 sts at **beg** (front edge) of next row, then in every foll alt row until there are 16 (**18-21-23-24-26**) sts.

Work 4 (**8-8-10-12-14**) rows stocking st ... 13 (**19-21-23-27-29**) rows in all.

Shape Armhole & Front Slope -

Cast off 2 (**2-3-3-3-4**) sts at beg of next row ... 14 (**16-18-20-21-22**) sts.

Dec one st at armhole edge in next row, then in every foll alt row 1 (**1-1-2-2-2**) times, AT SAME TIME dec one st at front edge in next row, then in every foll alt row 3 (**3-2-3-3-1**) times, then in every foll 4th row until 5 (**6-8-8-9-10**) sts rem.

Cont without shaping until **armhole** measures same as Back to beg of shoulder shaping, ending with a knit row.

Shape Shoulder -

Cast off rem 5 (**6-8-8-9-10**) sts.

SLEEVES

Using 4.00mm needles, cast on 30 (**32-32-34-36-36**) sts.

Work 2 rows stocking st.

3rd row - K2, **M1**, knit to last 2 sts, **M1**, K2.

Cont inc one st (as before) at each end of every foll 4th (**8th-8th-10th-10th-8th**) row until there are 36 (**38-40-42-44-46**) sts.

Cont without shaping until sleeve measures 7 (**9-12-14-15-17**) cm (or 4cm less than length desired to allow for edging) from beg, ending with a purl row.

Shape Top -

Cast off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows ... 32 (**34-36-38-40-42**) sts.

Dec one st at each end of next row, then in every foll alt row until 14 (**14-14-14-18-18**) sts rem, then in every row until 8 sts rem.

Cast off.

BACK AND FRONTS EDGING

Using mattress st, join shoulder and side seams.

Using 4.00mm needles, cast on 6 sts.

1st row (wrong side) - Knit.

2nd row - K1, K2tog, yfwd, K2, (yfwd) twice, K1 ... 8 sts.

3rd row - K2, K1 tbl, K2tog, yfwd, K3.

4th row - K1, K2tog, yfwd, K5.

5th row - Cast off 2 sts, leaving one st on right hand needle, K2tog, yfwd, K3 ... 6 sts.

Rows **2** to **5** incl form patt.

Cont in patt until edging fits evenly along cast on edge of Back, along Fronts and across back neck, ending with a 5th patt row.

Cast off knitways.

SLEEVE EDGINGS (make 2)

Work as for Back and Fronts Edging until edging fits along cast on edge of Sleeves, then working extra length to gather sleeve edging slightly.

TO MAKE UP

DO NOT PRESS. Using a flat seam, sew side edge of Back and Fronts Edging to Jacket, beginning and ending at centre back neck. Join cast on and cast off edges of edging together. Using mattress st, join sleeve seams.

Sew in sleeves. Using a flat seam, join cast on and cast off edges of Sleeve Edging together. Stitch side edge of Sleeve Edging to cast on edge of Sleeve, gathering to fit and placing seam of sleeve to seam of edging. Work other Sleeve in same manner. Thread length of ribbon through eyelet holes of edging at beginning of front slope shaping. Tie in a bow as pictured.

HAT

Using 4.00mm needles, cast on 58 (**66-74-82-82-90**) sts. Work in stocking st until work measures 6 (**7-7-8-9-10**) cm (2cm has been allowed for edging) from beg, ending with a purl row.

Shape Crown -

1st row - K2, * K2tog, K6, rep from * to end ... 51 (**58-65-72-72-79**) sts.

Work 3 rows stocking st, beg with a purl row.

5th row - K2, * K2tog, K5, rep from * to end ... 44 (**50-56-62-62-68**) sts.

Work 1 (**3-3-3-3-3**) row/s stocking st, beg with a purl row.

Next row - K2, * K2tog, K4, rep from * to end ... 37 (**42-47-52-52-57**) sts.

Work 1 (**1-1-3-3-3**) row/s stocking st, beg with a purl row.

Next row - K2, * K2tog, K3, rep from * to end ... 30 (**34-38-42-42-46**) sts.

Work 1 (**1-1-1-1-3**) row/s stocking st, beg with a purl row.

Next row - K2, * K2tog, K2, rep from * to end ... 23 (**26-29-32-32-35**) sts.

Next row - Purl.

Next row - K2, * K2tog, K1, rep from * to end ... 16 (**18-20-22-22-24**) sts.

Next row - Purl.

Next row - (K2tog) 8 (**9-10-11-11-12**) times ... 8 (**9-10-11-11-12**) sts.

Break off yarn, leaving a long end.

Run end through rem sts, draw up tightly and fasten off securely.

EDGING

Using 4.00mm needles, cast on 6 sts.

1st row (wrong side) - Knit.

2nd row - K1, K2tog, yfwd, K2, (yfwd) twice, K1 ... 8 sts.

3rd row - K2, K1 tbl, K2tog, yfwd, K3.

4th row - K1, K2tog, yfwd, K5.

5th row - Cast off 2 sts, leaving one st on right hand needle, K2tog, yfwd, K3 ... 6 sts.

Rows **2** to **5** incl form patt.

Cont in patt until edging fits along cast on edge of Hat, adding a little extra length for a slight frill and ending with a 5th patt row.

Cast off knitways.

TO MAKE UP

DO NOT PRESS. Using a flat seam, sew side edge of edging to cast on edge of hat, slightly gathering to fit. Using mattress st, join back seam.



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
