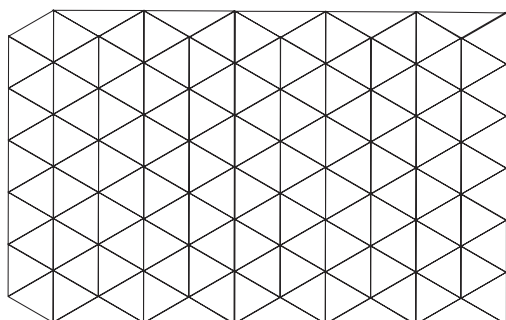


PRAM COVER OR COT BLANKET IN TRIANGLES

 Intermediate Knitting



MEASUREMENTS

		Pram	Cot
Length	cm	70	122
Width	cm	50	80

SHEPHERD COLOUR 4 ME 8 PLY 50g balls

Pram Cover

1st Colour (C1)	4
2nd Colour (C2)	4
3rd Colour (C3)	4
4th Colour (C4)	4

Cot Blanket (one colour)

Quantity	36
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Quantities are approximate as they can vary between knitters. Check the ball bands to ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.

NEEDLES AND EXTRAS

- 1 pair of 4.00mm knitting needles and a set of 4.00mm **double-pointed** knitting needles or the required size to give correct tension.
- wool needle for sewing seams.

TENSION

Edge of Triangle should measure 12cm, using 4.00mm needles. Please check your tension carefully. If less sts use smaller needles, if more sts use bigger needles.

PRAM COVER

TRIANGLE (make 10 in C1, 10 in C2, 11 in C3 and 11 in C4)

Using a **set** of 4.00mm **double-pointed** needles, cast on 78 sts, placing 26 sts on each of 3 needles.

1st round – Purl.

2nd round – Knit.

3rd round – On each needle, knit to last 2 sts, sl 1, K1, pssso ... 75 sts.

4th round – As 3rd round ... 72 sts.

5th round – As 3rd round ... 69 sts.

Note: When pattern specifies 'turn' – proceed as follows to avoid holes in work. Take yarn under needle and onto other side of work, slip next st onto right hand needle, take yarn under needle and back to original position, slip st back onto left hand needle, then turn and proceed as instructed in pattern (see page 33).

6th round – **Turn**, work as given for 3rd round ... 66 sts.

7th round – As 3rd round.

8th round – As 3rd round.

9th round – As 3rd round ... 57 sts.

Rep rounds 6 to 9 incl, until there is one st on each needle. Cast off.

HALF TRIANGLES (make 2 each in C1, C2 and C4)

Using a pair of 4.00mm needles, cast on 46 sts.

1st row (wrong side) – Knit.

2nd row – (P21, P2tog) twice ... 44 sts.

3rd row – (K2tog, K20) twice ... 42 sts.

4th row – (P19, P2tog) twice ... 40 sts.

5th row – (P18, P2tog) twice.

6th row – (K2tog, K17) twice.

7th row – (P16, P2tog) twice.

8th row – (K2tog, K15) twice ... 32 sts.

9th row – (K2tog, K14) twice.

10th row – (P13, P2tog) twice.

11th row – (K2tog, K12) twice.

12th row – (P11, P2tog) twice ... 24 sts.

13th row – (P10, P2tog) twice.

14th row – (K2tog, K9) twice.

15th row – (P8, P2tog) twice.

16th row – (K2tog, K7) twice ... 16 sts.

17th row – (K2tog, K6) twice.

18th row – (P5, P2tog) twice.

19th row – (K2tog, K4) twice.

20th row – (P3, P2tog) twice ... 8 sts.

21st row – (P2, P2tog) twice.

22nd row – (K2tog, K1) twice ... 4 sts.

Cast off.

With right side facing and using a pair of 4.00mm needles, cast on 2 sts, knit up 40 sts along longer edge of triangle, cast on 2 sts ... 44 sts.

1st row – Knit

2nd row – Purl.

Rep 1st row once.

Cast off purlways.

MAKE UP

Using wool needle and mattress st seam (see page 15),
join triangle pieces as illustrated on page 49.

COT BLANKET

Work 121 triangles (as given in Pram cover).
Work 10 half triangles (as given in Pram cover).

MAKE UP

Using mattress st, join triangle pieces as shown in diagram.



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
