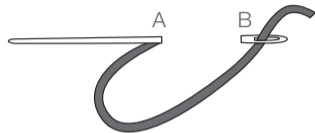


BULLION STITCH



Bring needle out of fabric at A.

Make a back stitch by inserting needle at B and out again at A, without pulling the needle right through. The length of this stitch is the length of the bullion stitch. Wind the yarn around the point of the needle as many times as required to cover the stitch length. Holding the left thumb over the coiled thread, pull the needle right through. Still holding the coiled thread insert needle back through fabric at B and pull right through.

A cluster of bullion stitches makes a grub rose.
