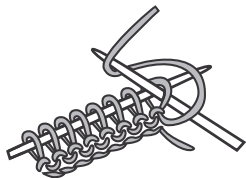
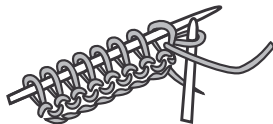


WORKING THE PURL STITCH



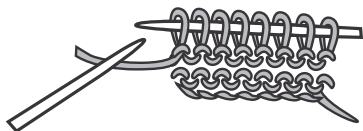
- 1 Insert needle from back to front into first stitch, with the right-hand needle going over the left-hand needle. Wrap yarn under, then over, the right-hand needle, working from right to left.



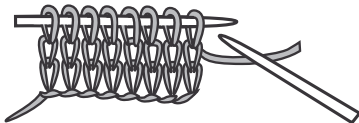
- 2 Using right-hand needle, draw loop through stitch on left-hand needle.



- 3 Slip stitch off left-hand needle ... one stitch purled.



- 4 Repeat steps 1, 2 and 3 until all stitches are purled from the left-hand needle onto the right-hand needle and the left-hand needle is empty.
You have completed one purl row.



- 5 Swap the needles around so that the needle holding the stitches is in your left hand and the empty needle is in your right hand.

- 6 To work stocking stitch, knit 1 row, then purl 1 row.
